Next meeting: Wednesday, May 29th

May 15th 2024: Meeting of Ad Hoc Committee. Agendas and minutes found on the Town website.

January 8th 2024: WP&R, Selectwoman and Tree Warden presented restoration plan to Inland Wetlands Commission. Plan was not approved.
