

★ ★ 2026 WP&R Teen Travel Camp ★ ★

We are very happy to provide a safe, fun and exciting Summer Day Camp experience for our Teen Travel Camp campers entering grades 7-9! Please read this document thoroughly and let us know if you have any questions or concerns.

REGISTRATION: 2026 Camp will run for five weeks: June 29th - July 31st. Register for as many weeks as you'd like. Teen Travel Camp runs Monday - Thursday only. No camp on Fridays.

Cancellations: If your camper is registered for the following week, and you must cancel, you must do so before noon the Thursday prior to receive a full refund. Any cancellations received after this deadline will not be subject to a refund.

Camp Registrations close for the upcoming week at noon on Thursday of the week before:

- Week 1 - must register by June 25th at 12:00 noon
- Week 2 - must register by July 2nd at 12:00 noon
- Week 3 - must register by July 9th at 12:00 noon
- Week 4 - must register by July 16th at 12:00 noon
- Week 5 - must register by July 23rd at 12:00 noon

DROP OFF/PICK UP: Every camper is checked into and out of camp for attendance and safety reasons. Drop off and pick up at Woodbury Middle School, 67 Washington Avenue. Drop off will be at 9:00am. Parent/guardian, join the car line as it makes it way to the camp entrance (behind the school, cafeteria door). Your child may only be picked up by a parent or person listed on the online registration form with photo I.D. Any changes need to be submitted in writing by 12:00pm day of. Do not drop off early as staff may not be on site. Late drop-offs risk missing the bus. Please be punctual, as we will not hold the bus for late arrivals.

Pick up will be at 3:00pm (Unless otherwise noted on weekly schedule). Parent/guardian, join the car line as it makes it way to the camp entrance.

It is important for everyone's safety that parents/guardians do not get out of the car during drop off and pick up. If you need to speak to the Camp Director please pull aside, out of the car line, before you exit your vehicle.

CAMP HOURS: 9:00am to 3:00pm, 4 days only! Depending on trip, some leave later, some return earlier. Please see the weekly schedule below.

UPDATES AS THEY HAPPEN: In the event of inclement weather, location issue or other reason, trips are subject to change. We will not cancel camp, just change the location. If this happens, parents/guardians will be notified by text message and email. For safety reasons, this is *not* an announcement that will not be on Facebook.

FIELD TRIPS: Trips will leave from WMS each day. Each camper will receive two camp t-shirts on *their first day of camp for the summer*. Campers must have their camp T-shirt on, or they will not be permitted to go. All trips are subject to change.

WAIVERS: Parents/guardians, you must complete and submit all waivers by drop-off on Monday for any trips occurring that week. Without a completed waiver, campers will not be allowed to attend the field trip. We encourage early submissions of waivers as it allows the camp day to run more smoothly. WHAT TO BRING: Lunch, drink, snack, refillable water bottle, closed-toe shoes, camp T-shirt, sunscreen, change of clothes/swimsuit if indicated, and a hat. Preferably all that in a zippered backpack. Note that our counselors will not apply your child's sunscreen but will periodically remind them to do so. Please do not bring any valuable or irreplaceable personal items. Our focus is always on the safety of our campers first and foremost; therefore, we cannot be responsible for any lost items. There will be a Lost & Found table for any unlabeled items left behind. Any remaining items will be donated at the end of camp.

MEDICATION & EMERGENCIES: Please indicate any allergies, medications, and any other medical information that staff should be aware of when you register. All our Summer Camp staff have been trained in First Aid, CPR and Epi Pen administration. We are not allowed to administer any other medication.

BEHAVIOR: We operate camp with the expectation that all participants will treat each other with kindness and respect, and that all campers will give their counselors their attention and follow instructions when receiving communication about activities, visitors, field trips, etc. Campers are encouraged to report to their counselors any issues or situations that make them uncomfortable. Our counselors and Summer Camp Director will make every reasonable effort to de-escalate any behavioral issues; however, we cannot allow any camper to disrupt camp or treat anyone in a disrespectful or dangerous manner. Bullying in any form, kicking, biting, throwing objects with malicious intent, swearing or inappropriate language will not be tolerated. Taking other people's property without permission is not allowed. Any camper who does not cooperate will receive a Disciplinary Action Form which will be given to the parent/guardian at the end of the day with an explanation of what happened to warrant

this report. Any camper who received three of these reports during the Camp Season will be expelled from camp and no refund will be given.

COMMUNICATION: Email will be the primary form of communication for general information. In the event of an emergency or anything time sensitive, you will receive a call or text alert. Please be sure that your contact information is up to date in your account, that you are subscribed to General Updates, and that you've marked us as a Known Sender in your contacts, so we do not go into the Spam/Junk folder.

REQUIRED: Please sign and return the last page of this document, certifying that you have read, understand and agree to abide by all WP&R Summer Camp Policies.

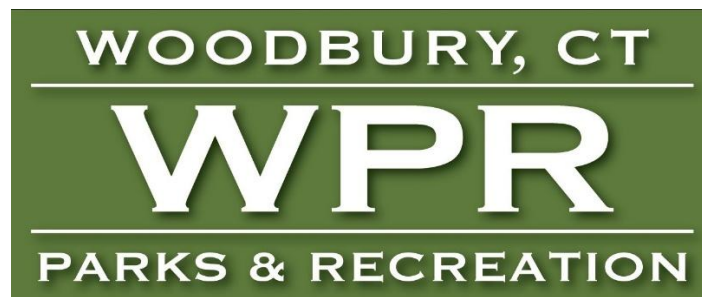
